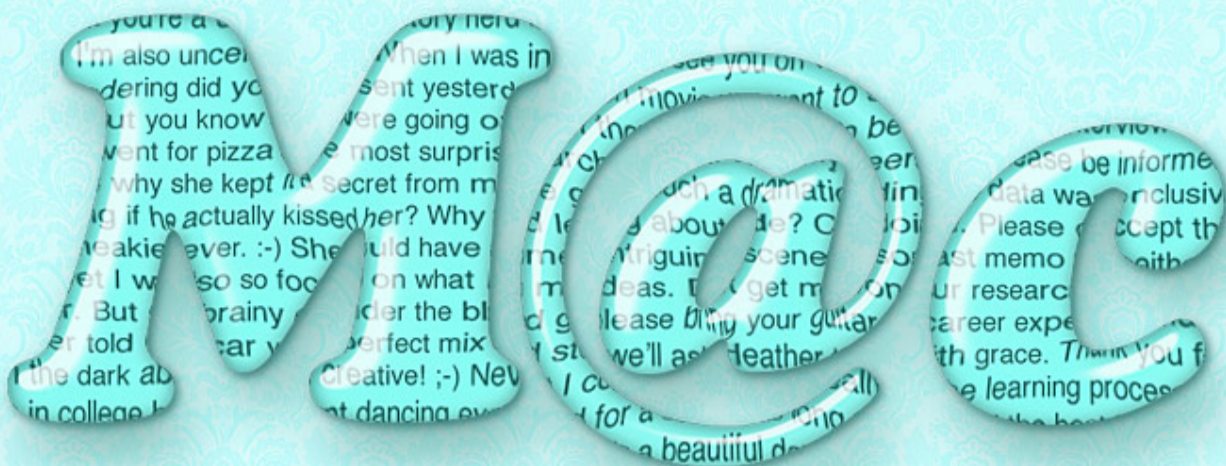

BACK TO MAC BASICS

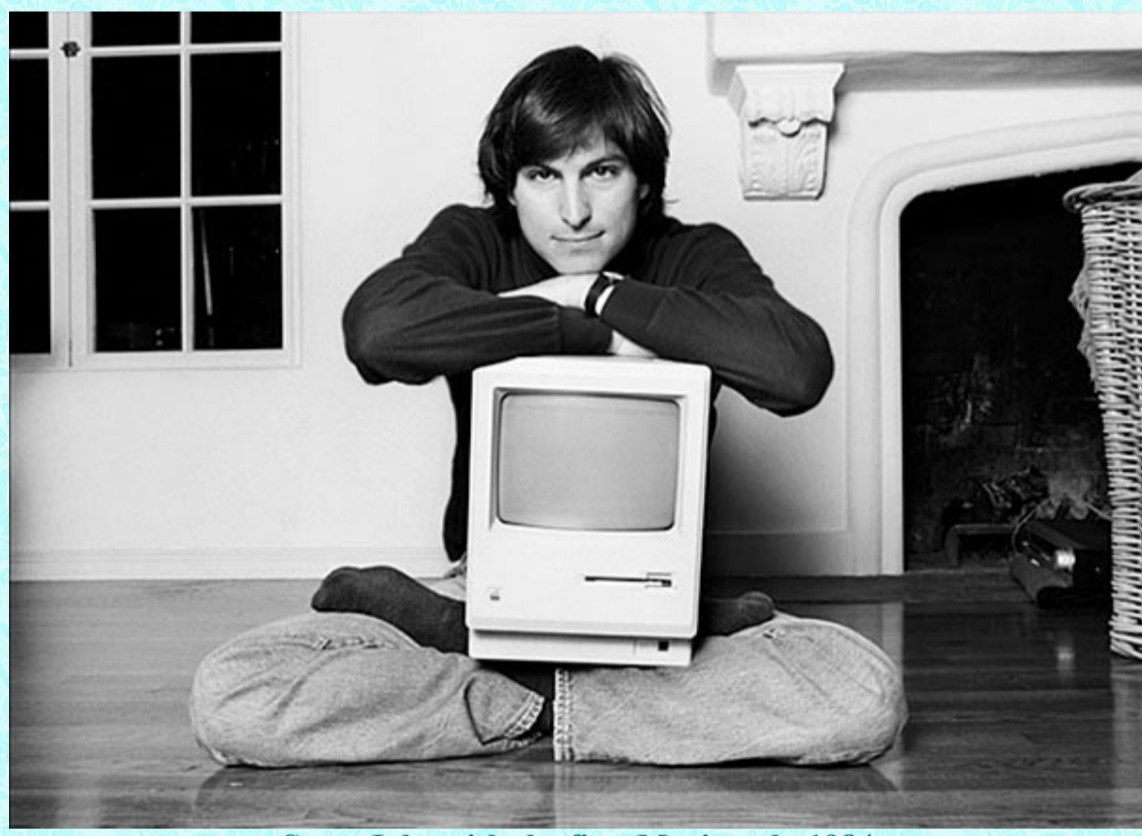
In this segment, we focus on more fundamental skills, to make life a little easier for those who are trying to learn how to use their Macs. This month:
