A live demonstration of how to use the Apple TV system to select, stream, watch and play whatever and whenever you want to be presented by Roger Owens

On Tuesday, Roger will show how to use AirPlay to play music from Macs and iOS devices through AirPlay speakers, and how to use Airplay to send movies to your television via an Apple TV, or mirror your iOS device's entire screen on your TV.
